1. Thread the Top Loop (J) to the top of the


Frame Coupler (P) until tight.

2.Feed the fixture wires through the Center Pipe (K)

and pull the fixture wires until taut.

3. Thread the Center Nipple (L) to the coupler on the

Fixture (Q).


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
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4. Slide Center Ring (H) up to the center of Arms (C) against the Steel Clip (G). 5.Fold the Steel Clip (G) carefully around the Center Ring (H) to lock tightly to the frame. NOTE: The Steel Clip is made of a flexible metal and will be bent under hand pressure. Use care, repeated folding up and down may cause the metal clip to break. 6. By measuring determine correct number of links needed for proper hanging height. Use a pair of plies to open one link of the Chain (C2) then remove the excess Chain (C2) and discard it. 7. Use one Chain Connector *E2) to attach one end of the chain to the Top Loop (D2) and close the Chain Connector (E2) 8. Feed the fixture wires through the Chain (every three links) and pull the wires until taut. 9. Slip Canopy Loop Collar (B2) over the chain, then do the same with the Canopy (F2). 10. When ready to complete the installation, Use the other chain connector and attach the other end of the chain to the Canopy Loop (A2) and close the chain connector. 11. Feed the wires through Canopy Loop (F) and Nipple (C) and pull until taut. * You may now install the fixture.

12. Install the light bulbs in accordance with the fixture's specifications.
